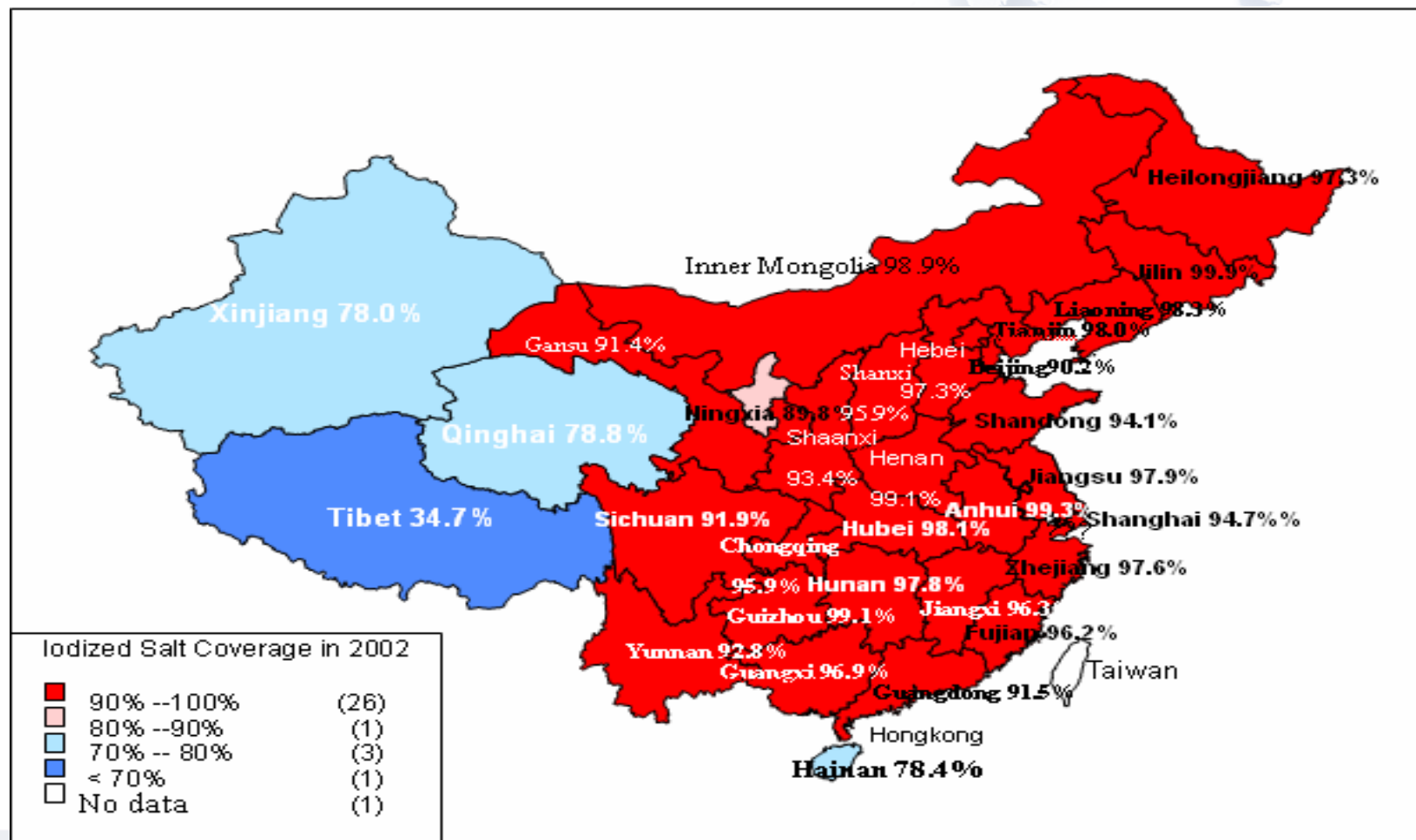

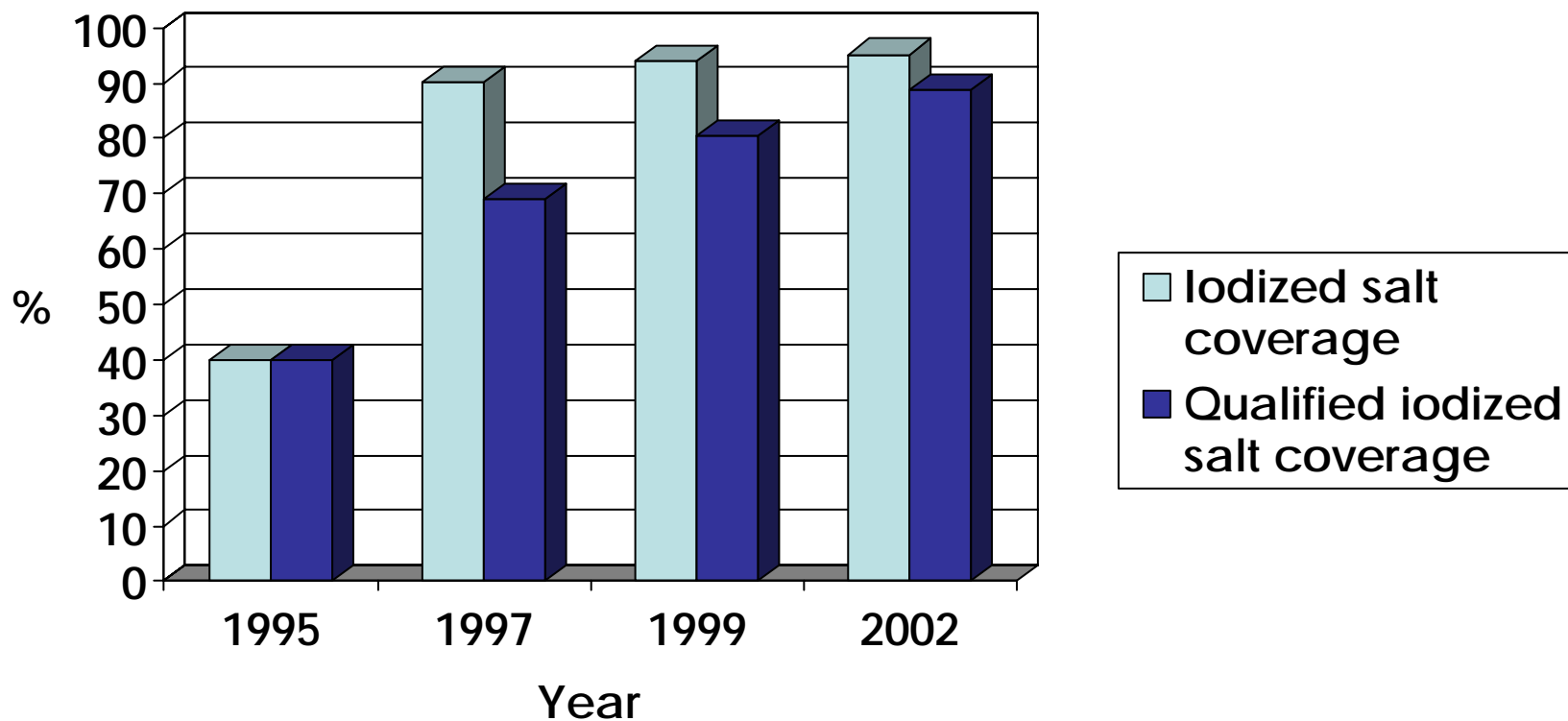
## Iodized Salt Coverage in 1995
